





What's A ProSolo Event?

What has staging lights, a starting tree, two cars side by side at the starting line, and a national series of competitions for money and prizes?

The NHRA's drag racing series you say? Well, no. I'm talking about the Sports Car Club of America's (SCCA) ProSolo autocross series. This unique motorsport combines autocross with a drag racing format to create an exciting national showcase autocross competition. Maybe you've heard of these events and wondered what all the fuss was about? So did I, so I decided to enter a ProSolo in May of this year in nearby Petersburg, VA.



For those who haven't ventured out to our NCC autocross events, let's review the basics: autocross is a low speed competitive event held in a large area such as a parking lot where cars drive one at a time through a course defined by traffic cones. While that's fun enough for most of us, the SCCA felt that a more exciting autocross event could be produced by laying out courses in a mirror image and having two cars run these courses simultaneously. A drag strip starting tree sending the cars out adds to the excitement. For drivers, another bonus comes in the format of the event, which offers twelve runs over a two-day period as compared to the usual three or four for the typical local autocross. ProSolo borrows SCCA's classing system meaning any car classed for SCCA Solo-II (autocross) competition is legal in ProSolo.

ProSolo is very popular among the national Solo-II crowd. A nine event national schedule comprises the ProSolo season culminating with the ProSolo Finale in Topeka, Kansas held in mid September. Some competitors travel to all nine events. Class winners at each event earn cash, prizes, and series points. Season champions are crowned after the series finale.

The closest ProSolo event on this year's schedule was held in Petersburg, VA, about 2-1/2 hours

south of D.C., in May. The facility is the parking lot of Virginia Motorsports Park — a drag racing facility. In previous years, events were also held in nearby Harrisburg, PA. The size of the VMP lot dwarfs most of the lots D.C. area autocrossers are used to. With mirror courses, however, each side is limited to less than 40 seconds for most cars. I ran my 1995 M3 in B-Street Prepared class which is mainly populated by modified Corvettes. The smaller courses of a ProSolo tend to favor more agile cars like BMWs rather than brute horsepower — good news for me!

What made the event especially fun was the opportunity to really hone those autocross skills. The format is eight runs on Saturday (four on each side), then two more on each side Sunday Morning. Having eight runs to perfect your technique leaves little of that "I could have gone faster if..." feeling that often accompanies a regular autocross. Despite that, I was none too close to ProSolo regular Jerry Onks in his 1996 Corvette after our eight runs Saturday.

By Sunday morning, with a night to sleep on it, I was ready to really let it all hang out for those final four runs. Somehow I managed not to overdo it at one of the informal social gatherings that broke out in the paddock Saturday evening during a heavy rain. Many people camp out at or near the event; the ProSolo community is close knit. I ran into D.C. autocross regulars Mike Snyder and Lee Piccione in the paddock who invited me to sample offerings from a Margarita machine they brought to the event!

Sunday morning I had both courses locked in my brain and managed to closely challenge Jerry's time while putting some distance on the third place car. Jerry answered by going even faster and won the class by .5 seconds when our best times from each course were totaled.



Another unique feature of a ProSolo is that the competition does not end Sunday morning after the normal 12 runs are completed! A "Challenge" round pitting class winners and those who's times were very close to the class winners is held using bracket drag racing style handicap starts. That means slower cars get to start first! Cars run head to head, then switch sides and do it again. The lowest total time moves on to the next round while the slower car is eliminated until one driver wins all. Challenge winners earn even more prize and contingency awards including cash, tires, and a guitar from the Peavey Electronics Corporation; a major sponsor of the ProSolo series.

But that's not all... a second challenge is added as a bonus to those not selected for the regular challenge round. Oddly, this round is called the "Bonus Challenge." Sixteen Bonus Challenge competitors are drawn from a hat and compete in the same manner as the regular Challenge round competitors, also for cash and prizes. Talk about total autocross immersion!

The big news for BMW drivers is that BMW is once again in the ProSolo contingency

game! BMW Motorsport offers cash awards for drivers who finish in the top three of class competition at all SCCA ProSolo events. Although my



time was not good enough to be invited to the challenge round at Petersburg, I did pocket some of BMW's money by virtue of a 2nd place in class finish. Yeah, BMW pays me to race cars... you know, me and Auberlen are like this now (crossing fingers).

The only thing I regret about attending a ProSolo is not doing it sooner. For more information,




